GEW ENERGY DOME

By Car, coming from A1 (Autobahn)

- 1: Take the B55, EXIT 103, toward
K.-Lövenich / K.-Weiden / K.-Junkersdorf.
- 2: Keep right at the fork to
go on Aachener Strasse / B55. 2.3 km
- 3: Turn right onto ramp. 200 m
- 4: Turn left onto Militärringstrasse / L34. 1.0 km
- 5: Turn slight right onto ramp. 200 m
- 6: Turn slight right onto
Widdersdorfer Strasse. 300 m
- 7: Turn left onto Girlitzweg. 200 m
- 8: Turn left to stay on Girlitzweg. 300 m
- 9: End at Girlitzweg 30
